TCWU Celebrates 10 Years

The Tuscarawas Clinic for the Working Uninsured is celebrating 10 years !

Dr. Brenda Prince was a founding member when the clinic began in February 2009 at St. Joseph's Church Family Life Center. She along with nurse Wendy Thomas began planning the clinic back in 2006.

"We were seeing working people without insurance who had chronic disease and no chance for follow up," Prince said. "We wanted to provide an opportunity for them to not only have health care but to take an active part in wellness by participat-

ing in necessary lifestyle changes."

Early discussions with other physicians including Drs. Jack Burnham, Jim Moore, Jeff



Cameron, Jennifer Gigax and Tom Kelly helped launch the clinic to what it is today.

Initial board members including Jack Dooling, Tim McKnight, Bob Moore, Kristin Zemis and Brenda Prince were instrumental in laying

the foundation for the clinic as a non profit entity and establishing policy.

Many volunteers along the way gave of their time and talents to help improve the healthcare of thousands of individuals in our county.

Dr. Prince continues to see patients monthly fulfilling the clinic purpose to help those who are making a sincere effort to help themselves, by providing a place where the patients can obtain assistance managing their health care needs.
